Commerce Preliminarily Finds Dumping of Emulsion Styrene-Butadiene Rubber from Italy

On April 26, 2022, the Department of Commerce (Commerce) announced its affirmative preliminary determination in the antidumping duty (AD) investigation of emulsion styrene-butadiene rubber from Italy.
